Prospects

1. Learning advanced skills of Case Receiving, Case Analysis, Case Processing & Case Synthesis in Homoeopathic Clinical Practice
2. Learning the concepts, methods and techniques for the integrated study of applied Organon, Materia Medica and Repertory in Clinical Practice
3. Evolving a conceptual framework and sound reasoning abilities to manage all aspects of Homoeopathic Practice effectively and in a standardized manner
4. Acquiring the capacity to guide and supervise fresh learners in clinical and group sessions as per the competence achieved

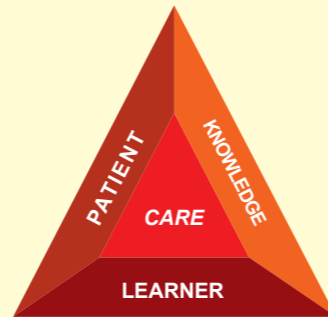

Dr. M. L. Dhawale, the doyen of Homoeopathy & our teacher, established the Institute of Clinical Research in 1975 for imparting post-graduate education in Homoeopathy.

He identified the triad of Patient-Care, Student-Care & Knowledge-Care (Research) as the foci for harnessing the energies of the young physician to achieve Professional Excellence. Dr. Dhawale turned the entire group of learners into guides/teachers of each other by embracing the group discussion method, since in a lecture, it is only the lecturer learns the most while in a group setting, all participants benefit as per their contribution.



Following his sad demise in 1987, the Dr M L Dhawale Memorial Trust was established in his name, to actualize his vision of service through Homoeopathy. The Trust works with the mission –

"To achieve excellence in 'Integrated Homoeopathic Medical Care, Education and Research in order to promote 'Positive Health' in a cost-effective manner."

In pursuit of our vision, the MLD Memorial Organizations (MLD Trust, MLDMHI, and HECT) have set up Homoeopathic Hospitals, Post-graduate Centres and Charitable Clinics in and around Mumbai, Pune, Kolhapur, Vadodara and Bengaluru. Manned by trained clinicians, the Standardised Homoeopathic Practice at these places forms the base for all education, training and research.

With 5 hospitals (2 in Mumbai, 1 in Palghar, 1 in Bhopoli & 1 in Sumeru, Gujarat) and with 8 clinics in Mumbai, 6 rural clinics around Palghar, two mobile clinics around Manor near Palghar, 4 clinics at Pune, a clinic in Kolhapur, 3 in and around Vadodara and a number of clinics and Mobile Homoeopathic services at Bengaluru, the Organizations provide ample opportunities for Homoeopaths to get clinical training. Exposure to Homoeopathic IPD under the guidance of Consultants belonging to these specialties is another challenging learning opportunity.

Dr. M. L. Dhawale Memorial Trust conducts scientific research through various research projects in the field of Homoeopathy. Today we have completed four extra-mural Clinical Homoeopathic Research projects in Diabetes, Diarrhoea and Scabies in tribal children and Learning Disabilities which have signified a breakthrough in the further reach of Scientific Standardized Homoeopathy into hitherto untackled clinical areas.

THE COURSES

With a 36-years old track record of education, the Institute courses have sound philosophical tenets, utilize time-tested methodology of education and achieve a unique merger of scholarship, sound knowledge of Homoeopathic concepts and a vast on-hands clinical experience.

THE INTERNS ORIENTATION PROGRAMME IN HOMOEOPATHY

Contact Lectures

These lectures aim to make interns acquainted with our approach, and are free for all.

Interns Orientation Course

This Course will have the dual components of Discussion Sessions and Clinical Sessions.

BASIC COURSE IN THE PRINCIPLES & PRACTICE OF HOMOEOPATHY – THE ICR WAY

Eligibility - Physicians who have completed their internship (full-timers) and also physicians who are already in practice (Part-timers).

1. Learning basic skills of Case Receiving & Case Analysis in Homoeopathy
2. Learning the basics of an integrated study of applied Organon, Materia Medica and Repertory in Clinical Practice
3. Learning to manage commonly encountered diseases in Homoeopathic Practice effectively and in a standardized manner
4. Eligibility to join the One –and-a-half year Regular Training Course of the I.C.R. to acquire the Certificate of Professional Competence
5. Handling clinical responsibilities at the various charitable centers of the Institute under expert guidance

The Course will have 4 components

Discussion Sessions – 2 per week

Clinical Sessions – Morn / Even – 1 each for part-timers, as per faculty decision for full-timers

Month-End Seminars – 6 in all – On all basic aspects of Homoeopathic practice

English Enrichment Programme – 1 / week for the first 10 weeks

Curriculum

A Basic initiation in Homoeopathic philosophy & practice through ICR methodology.

1. Case Receiving & Clinical Interview
