DETAILS ABOUT CME, SEMINARS -

MKSHMC has since inception implemented Integrated Medical Education program for the students. Module wise curriculum and its culmination in a Seminar by students under supervision has been the hallmark of the College. The Academic council has been working continuously to plan the curriculum and seminars from the $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ BHMS to $\mathbf{4}^{\text{th}}$ BHMS students.

The seminars on IME are being conducted every 4 months for all the years. This helps students to understand practical aspect of Homoeopathy in a better way.
